The Ocoee Regional Cancer Foundation (ORCF) is a non-profit organization that helps people from our covered area who are being treated with radiation therapy for cancer to afford the treatment they need and assist in transportation.

It is the generosity of individuals, local businesses and other organizations that enables ORCF to fulfill its mission. We are pleased that 99% of donations made to the ORCF go directly to help approved eligible recipients of radiation therapy.

A cancer diagnosis can lead to financial strain on patients and families. Patients receiving radiation treatments must travel daily to and from treatments, sometimes traveling long distances. Some of these patients must make daily choices between gas or food or medicine. The ORCF provides funds to cover expenses associated with radiation therapy such as treatments, gas vouchers, taxi fares and other required non-covered medical care. The ORCF is here to make things a little easier for eligible patients in their time of need.

To Qualify

Financial assistance grants thru ORCF are available to those diagnosed with cancer:

- Who live in and are seeking radiation oncology treatments in Bradley, Polk, Meigs, and McMinn Counties.
- Those with special financial needs and whose gross household incomes do not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- To qualify you must show proof of income and complete an application process with your OCF treatment coordinator.
- The Ocoee Regional Cancer Foundation is available to eligible cancer patients who live in and receive radiation treatments in the four county service area of Bradley, Polk, Meigs and McMinn.

Our goal is to make sure any needy patient can have financial assistance to get the treatments they need. With your help we can greatly improve the emotional well-being of a suffering human being.
